

C.M.G.* (1916); R.C.A. 1886, President *Royal Canadian Academy of Arts* 1909-1918; born Greenock 14 Dec. 1855; son of late <u>Dr. Douglas Brymner</u>, Dominion Archivist; married 1917 **Mary Caroline Massey**. Education: *St. Francis College*, Richmond, Canada. Went to Paris 1878 where studied painting under **W. A. Bougereau**, **Tony Robert Fleury** and **Carolus Duran**.



Returned to Montreal in 1886 to take charge of the art classes of the *Montreal Art Association*; awarded a gold medal for painting by the international jury at the *Pan-American Buffalo Exposition*, 1901, and a silver medal at the *St. Louis Exposition* 1904.
