Acting King's (Foreign Service) Messenger, 1944; ret. 1945. Employed with British Military Administration (Libya) 1947 - 1948; resigned 1948 to settle in Southern Rhodesia; employed in South Rhodesia and Rhodesian and Federal Governments as temporary civil servant, 1948 - 1961.
