

Shot Him Dead

A Quarrel Over Wages Up in Colorado Results in the Death of The Employer

Grant Colo., Nov. 20. – **Charles Brymer** killed **Jno. Swedley** yesterday in Webster gulch and gave himself up to-day. **Swedley** owed **Brymer** three months' wages and refused to pay him. It is said that he even struck **Brymer** with an axe when the latter demanded pay. **Brymer** walked to Denver sixty miles away bought a revolver, and walked back. Meeting **Swedley** in Webster gulch he exclaimed "Now I have got you where I want you," and shot him dead. **Swedley** leaves a wife and three children.
