Edinburgh, Sunday.

Four persons were killed in two road smashes in the Edinburgh district yesterday...

The second accident occurred in the Morningside district of Edinburgh last night. The victims were **Elizabeth Brebner** (50), of Hermitage Gardens, Edinburgh, and **Thomas Elliott** (33), engineer of Lochrin Buildings, Edinburgh. **Miss Brebner** was escorting a niece from a party when a motor-car collided with an electric standard and **Miss Brebner** was knocked down and killed instantly. **Elliott** was a passenger in the car, the driver of which and another man were removed to the infirmary.

Elizabeth Brebner was the eldest of seven children to civil engineer **Robert Charles Brebner** and **Mary Elizabeth Wallace**.

The family descends from the Tarland **Brebner** family of **John Brebner** and **Margaret Williams**.
