

Mrs. Charles Brebner Injured in Accident

Sustains Fracture of Hip When Machine Leaves Road, News Notes

Campbell, April 22. –

Mrs. James Hyatt of Los Gatos road and her parents **Mr.** and **Mrs. Charles Brebner** of San Jose met with an accident Wednesday evening in which their automobile was overturned and **Mrs. Brebner** sustained a broken hip. No one else was injured and the damage to the machine was slight.

The auto had been presented to **Mrs. Hyatt** by her father, who was teaching her how to run it. They had been out for a large part of the day and were near home when a wrong move on the part of the new driver took the machine out of the road on the slope of the embankment at the head of Dry Creek road. It rolled over gently, but **Mrs. Brebner**, who was in the back seat, was injured. The extent of the injury was not known until an X-ray photograph was taken the next day by **Dr. Dickinson** of San Jose, who is attending the case.

The patient, though strapped in a fracture bed is comfortable and faces cheerfully the prospect of ten weeks of inaction. She will remain at her daughter's. **Mr.** and **Mrs. Brebner's** home is at 84 South Fifth street, San Jose.

Charles Brebner and **Melissa McLellan** (the **Mrs. Brebner** mentioned above) raised a family of (at least) three children in Northwood, IA. They moved to California some time before 1910.
