Joseph M. Brymer, the well known plumber of East End died shortly after noon yesterday at his home, 140 Scott street, of kidney and liver trouble. He was nearly 55 years of age and was respected by all who knew him. While he had not been feeling very well for some time past he was around looking after his business as usual up until a week ago. He is survived by his wife and two sons, **Arthur** and **Carl**, and a sister, **Mrs. Hendershott**, of Kingston.
