Subsequently coming under the general pardon, he settled in Auchmaliddie Farm, and married Margaret Johnston, of the Loanhead branch of the "clan." On 24th April, 1778 they had a son, baptised William, besides whom they had two other children. The parents dying when the children were in infancy, William Johnston, merchant, Savoch, adopted them, and William Brebner succeeded Mr. Johnston in both shop and farm. He married Margaret Garden, Ardlethen, Ellon, and they had a family of twelve, of whom was James Brebner....."

" A son of the latter is James Brebner, the present tenant of Green of Savoch, whose deceased wife Elsie Fiddes Walker, was a daughter of John Walker, Blackpots, Old Deer and his wife, Margaret Low."

"By agriculturalists generally throughout the north as well as by many friends in the city and county of Aberdeen, the intimation of the death of Mr. Alexander Brebner, Balquindachy, will be received with sincere regret. Mr. Brebner, who came from a worthy race of agriculturalists, succeeded his father on the farm of Balquindachy -- the largest on the Aberdeen estates -- and here his thorough knowledge of modern agriculture made his pursuit of it successful and profitable in no small measure. He was a recognized authority on all matters of husbandry, and on such his advice was much sought after and listened to. Mr. Brebner, who had a university training, was a member of the Parochial Board and School Board, and in these capacities also his assistance was gladly welcomed. It should be mentioned also that a visit to deceased's farm could not fail to convince one that Mr. Brebner had ever been ready to invest his capital in the interest alike of servant, farmer, and landlord. By Lord and Lady Aberdeen Mr. Brebner was held in high esteem, and during his illness he was visited more than once by his Lordship. From a wide surrounding district also many inquirers called when it became known that the worthy farmer was seriously ill. Mr. Brebner, who was in his 54th year, died of pneumonia which supervened upon a serious attack of bronchitis. His wife predeceased him fourteen years ago, but he is survived by two daughters and three sons. One of the latter -- Alexander -- a distinguished graduate of Aberdeen Grammar School. As indicated, Mr. Brebner had many friends in this city as well as in the county, his cheerful sociality endearing him to all he met. He was a member of the Church of Scotland. In the district of Methlick deceased, in an unostentatious way, was generous and charitable to all the poor, who will lose by his death a kind-hearted friend."

"The funeral of Mr. Alexander George BREBNER of Balquindochy, Methlick, whose whole life was devoted to the interests of his native parish in many directions, took place yesterday from Balquindochy to Methlick Churchyard, and the obsequies were attended by the largest concourse of mourners that has ever been seen in that part of the county."

"The entire district was in mourning, and the gathering was an eloquent tribute to one who has left a fine memory of uprightness, public service, and fair dealing. His passing will be an irreparable loss to Methlick."

"Long procession. In the long procession -- there were about eighty motor cars -- were the Marquis of Aberdeen and Temair and the Earl of Haddo."

"Mr. BREBNER was a close friend of Lord and Lady Aberdeen, and was always their right hand man at all the Haddo House functions. Lady Aberdeen joined the cortege at the churchyard."

"The chief mourners and pall-bearers were:-- Mr. John GRANT, Auchenuive, Whiterashes (brother-in-law); Mr. Wm. GRANT, bank agent, Methlick, (brother-in-law); Mr. R.L. ROGER, Aberdeen, and Miss ROGER; Mrs. GRANT, Bank House, Methlick; Mrs. GRANT, Auchenhuive, Whiterashes."

"At Methlick Churchyard the committal service was conducted by the Rev. Mr. SUTHERLAND, and the deceased was laid to rest in the family vault just under the shadow of the ivy-clad wall of the ancient church."

"In his prayer, the Ref. Mr. SUTHERLAND offered thanks for all that the late Mr. BREBNER was in that place, and they remembered with grateful hearts his sterling uprightness, the sacredness with which he held the bond of truth and honour, his high sense of duty, his abhorrence of all that savoured of sham and unreality."

"Thanks were also offered for his long, faithful and valued services to the community and the church which he dearly loved. They remembered his surpassing devotion to and love for his home, and they commended her who was mourning for the loss of her dear helpmate."
