Succeeded his father in 1702 (Acc. BURKE), lived at Corskie; had 4 brothers, d.s.p., and two sisters (Burke LG 1953).  
Listed in 1696 Poll Records for Aberdeen and Freedom Lands, "stock under 10,000 merks, no wife, child nor servant"  
Elected guild burghess 22 September 1685.  
James was a Jacobite supporter in the '15, but seems to have suffered no ill effects from that association.
