

1. **John Bremner** #2679 b. c 1761,¹ occupation Farmer, m. 25 JUN 1811, in Rothiemay, BAN, SCT,² **Helen Cook** #2678, b. c 1773, Rothiemay, BAN, SCT,³ 17 AUG 1773, Rothiemay, BAN, SCT,⁴ (daughter of **John Cook** #25611 and **Jane Gordon** #25612) d. 22 NOV 1862, Tillydoun, Grange, BAN, SCT,⁵ buried: Grange Churchyard, BAN, SCT. John died 07 NOV 1849, Tillydoun, Grange, BAN, SCT.⁶ **Helen**: 1851-61: Widowed, living with children at Tillydoun, Marnoch.

- i **Margaret Bremner** #2682 b. MAR 1812, Rothiemay, BAN, SCT, MAR 1812, Rothiemay, BAN, SCT, d. 21 MAR 1908, South St., Aberchirder, BAN, SCT.⁷ 1851: Lived in Marnoch unmarried; 1881: With widowed sister Elizabeth. Note that mother's name is given as 'Margaret' on her death certificate.
 - ii **William Bremner** #2680 b. JUN 1814, Rothiemay, BAN, SCT, 02 JUL 1814, Marnoch, BAN, SCT,² occupation Farmer of 55 acres, d. 23 SEP 1868, Tillydoun, Grange, BAN, SCT,⁸ buried: Grange Churchyard. 1851/61: Lived at Tillydown. (unmarried).
 - iii **Elizabeth Bremner** #2681 b. NOV 1815, Marnoch, BAN, SCT, 18 NOV 1815, Marnoch, BAN, SCT,² m. 12 DEC 1861, in Marnoch, BAN, SCT,⁹ **William Milne** #10483, (son of **William Milne** #13491 and **Agnes Thain** #13492) occupation Builder, d. before 1881. Elizabeth died 13 APR 1898, Aberchirder, BAN, SCT.¹⁰ listed in 1851 census, unmarried; widow of William MILNE at death in 1898. Died at Banffshire Asylum (Lunatic). 1881: Lived with sister Margaret at South Street, Marnoch. **William**: IGI lists no children from this union.
