1. **George Brebner** #2835, b. c 1770 in Marnoch?, BAN, SCT, d. JUN 1835 in Forgiestown, Marnoch, BAN, SCT,<sup>1</sup> occupation Farmer. George's will leaves monies to his wife and children as well as to his brother John.... possibly sons of William BREBNER/Agnes JOHNSTON?

Married in (no OPRI record found AUG 2010), **Isabel Hutcheon** #2836, b. c 1770 in Marnoch?, BAN, SCT, d. before MAY 1869.

*Children:*

- i. **Agnes Bremner** #2837, b. OCT 1789 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT, baptized 18 OCT 1789 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT.<sup>2</sup> 1835: Noted in father's will, inherited 25 GBP "unless she should be married in which case one half should be paid at the time of the marriage and the other half as above" (12 months after termination of farm lease).
- ii. **John Bremner** #2841, b. MAR 1792 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT, baptized 31 MAR 1792 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT.<sup>2</sup> Not mentioned in father's will... died infancy?
- iii. **George Bremner** #2838, b. MAR 1794 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT, baptized 23 MAR 1794 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT,<sup>2</sup> d. 10 MAY 1869 in Boat of Turtory, BAN, SCT,<sup>3</sup> occupation Farmer.  
1835: Noted in father's will.  
1841: Farmed at Scabbiescur, Marnoch...verify! Mother lived with him...no sign of wife.  
  
He married **Isabella (unidentified)** #2863. **Isabella**: living with George in 1851 census, Marnoch; wife ?? (this can't be Isabella Archibald).
- iv. **Helen Brebner** #2839, b. NOV 1796 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT, baptized 13 NOV 1796 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT.<sup>2</sup> 1835: Mentioned in father's will: ""To my daughter Helen the sum of Fifteen Pounds Stg. payable as specified".
- v. **William Brebner** #2842, b. AUG 1800 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT, baptized 21 AUG 1800 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT.<sup>2</sup>
- vi. **James Brebner** #2840, b. JAN 1806 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT, baptized 05 JAN 1806 in Marnoch, BAN, SCT.<sup>2</sup>
