Married 09 APR 1850 in Perth, PER, SCT,<sup>10</sup> John Begley (Begg) #46305, b. c 1825 in Blair Athol, PER, SCT,<sup>11</sup> occupation Railway Labourer/Coal Carter. John:

1851: Family lived on Barrack St., Perth (no children).

- 1861: Lived at 7 Hunter Street, Dundee with four children. Did they all die in infancy?...
- 1871: Lived with wife at Pullar Close, Murraygate, Dundee, ANS. Name changed to "BEGG"

1875: Note that John's surname is shown as "BEGG" on wife Susan's death certificate.
