"A TRAGEDY -- TWO LONELY WOMEN."

"The deaths of the two inmates of a large house at West Hill, Sydenham -- Mrs. WOOD, and octogenarian, a wealthy widow, and her aged nurse-housekeeper, Marie LEASON -- have revealed a pathetic tragedy (says a London paper). When the police entered the house, they found the dead body of the old servant huddled up at the bottom of the basement stairs, and her aged mistress lying on the floor by the side of her bed on the point of expiring from starvation and exhaustion. As she was lifted on to the bed she breathed for a short time and then passed away. At the inquest it was stated that Mrs. WOOD was a daughter of Mr. James BREMNER, and eminent engineer, of Wick, Scotland, who at one time was associated with Brunel, the famous engineer. The body of Miss WOOD was identified by Miss Helen Halsall BELL of Hazeldene, Ightham, Kent, as that of her great-aunt. She last saw her on Saturday, December 21st, when she was in good health. She always spent the winter in bed, but was able to get up without assistance. Miss LEASON, who had been with her twenty-five years, was absolutely trustworthy and reliable."

"Another witness said it was possible that Miss LEASON tripped over a large bag of onions which was in the passage and fell as she was about to go upstairs. Dr. Hugh BEADLES, police surgeon, said that the post-mortem showed a few small bruises on the right leg, but nothing more. The body was very emaciated. The stomach showed signs that she had not had food for a considerable time. The cause of death was exhaustion from want of nourishment. He thought she had been without food for two or three days. As to the death of Miss LEASON, Dr. BEADLES stated that her left wrist was broken, as were also the second and third ribs on the left side. The left side of her face was slightly bruised. Her liver weighed 72 oz, the normal weight being between 40 oz and 60 oz. His opinion was that she had been dead from three to five days. The cause of death was shock following a broken neck and injury to the spinal cord."

"The jury returned a verdict in accordance with the medical evidence in the case of Mrs. WOOD, and in that of Miss LEASON one of "accidental death." The verdict in the case of Mrs. WOOD was also finally returned as one of "accidental death," the coroner stating that this was the effect of the evidence."

- " A large section of our readers will learn with profound regret of the death, in the prime of his manhood, of Mr. D.J. BREMNER, Secretary of the Wellington Woolen Company, which occurred at his residence in Tinakori-road last night, after a brief illness."
- "A week ago yesterday Mr. BREMNER went home from the mill feeling unwell, and the following evening he was unable to attend the annual meeting of the shareholders in the company. Symptoms of pneumonia afterwards developed, and this was the cause of his death. He was generally popular, and his relations with all concerned in the Wellington Wool Company -- commenced about eight years ago -- were of a most cordial character. The directors had the very highest opinion of his integrity and ability -- an opinion shared by all with whom he had business transactions."
- "Mt. BREMNER was the son of a Glasgow banker, and was educated in Scotland and Germany, afterwards going out to Mexico where he had some experience both in silver mining and mercantile matters. HARCOURT and Co., which position he filled until that firm closed its business as warehousemen on Lambton-quay. He was then appointed Secretary to the Wellington Woollen Company, which office he filled until his death. He was married to a daughter of the late Dr. FEATHERSTON, and was therefore a brother-in-law to the Hon. C.J. JOHNSTON, M.L.C., and Dr. NEWMAN, M.H.R. He was a nephew of Mr. C. Napier BELL, Civil Engineer, and also of Major VON TEMPSKY, of whose heroic conduct in the New Zealand war no New Zealander need be reminded. " A Prairie Mansion"

" A visit to the fine farm of Mr. J.C.C. BREMNER in the Clover Bar district near Edmonton, whoed (sic) very convincingly what can be done by a pioneer farmer. Thirty-nine years ago Mr. BREMNER came to Alberta by Red River cart, acquired his homestead, built his shack, and started to clear and break up his land. Today modern barns, up-to-date outbuildings, and "a house which would grace a residential corner in a modern city" form the equipment of a flourishing 800 acre farm. Sitting on the veranda at afternoon tea, it was difficult to imagine that one had motored 16 miles into the prairie. The transformation was amazing, yet its record was plainly written. We saw the original ox-cart in which Mr. BREMNER first came to what is now the Bremner district. It lies near the site of the original shack, in a clump of bush, which has grown up around it. It has served its day. Its owner now does his business in a big modern motor car, which can get over the somewhat uneven prairie roads at a pace a good deal faster than the patient oxen pulled this cart across the unbroken prairie. All around was evidence of careful farming and a sense of prosperity and comfort. One minor point, which is not always appreciated on prairie, impressed the Scottish visitors, and that was the care bestowed on all the binders and other farm machinery. All were kept under cover, and not left in the open at the mercy of the weather. When depreciation is considered, such care counts for a good deal."

"Bremner's Nurse Sues"

"Asks for Life Pay of \$150 a Month -- Woman Declares Congressman Cancer Victim Promised Her That Sum."

"New York, Dec. 30 -- Mis Theodora Nash, a trained nurse, has sued in Jersey City for \$150 a month for three years and \$150 a month for the rest of her life from the estate of Congressman Robert G. Bremner, who died on February 4 last in Baltimore, where radium worth \$100,000 was applied in the attempt to cure him of cancer."

"Miss Nash says that soon after she met Bremner three years ago, when she was a nurse in a local sanitarium, he promised to pay her \$150 a month if she would nurse him till his death, and to provide in his will that she should have \$150 a month for life. Miss Nash said that no part of this was paid and that she was not mentioned in his will."

"Mr. Bremner and his wife were separated for several months before his death, but they were reunited while he was dying in Baltimore."

"An application has been made to Vice Chancellor Walker to restrain the Bremner estate from selling the Passaic Herald, of which he was the proprietor."

"Leitch (sic) Bremner, a brother of the late Congressman, who is in charge of the Passaic Herald, issued a statement last night denying that there was ground for the suit and attacking Miss Nash."

"Passaic, N.J. Jan. 16 -- Leith Bremner, brother of Representative Robert Gunn Bremner, now dead, received word to-day from his counsel, William B. Passed away October 21, 2011 in Royal University Hospital, Saskatoon following recurrent infections, but thankfully no dementia. He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Muriel, a resident of Luther Special Care Home, by two children, both residing in Saskatoon, daughter Margaret (married to Bruce Filson) and their three daughters (Chloë, Lydia, Veronica), and son Murray. He was predeceased by his only sibling, younger brother Gordon of Toronto. Activities in his busy life included: education in Toronto at Runnymeade Public School and at the University of Toronto School; graduation as MD from the University of Toronto in 1945; military service with Royal Canadian Army Medical Corps for three years; appointment as Senior Research Officer with Atomic Energy of Canada Limited at Chalk River; general medical practice for four years in communities in Ontario; post-graduate studies for five years in Toronto, Britain and Europe; recognition as a certified specialist in Dermatology and Syphilology in 1954 and subsequent acceptance as Fellow of the College of Physicians of Canada. He moved to Saskatoon in 1954 with his young family to establish the city's first private practice in dermatology which he continued for 35 years until his retirement in 1990. During these years he served all three of Saskatoon's hospitals, taught in all three nursing schools, and taught pro bono for more than eight hours per week in the College of Medicine at the U of S for 17 years. In late 1966 he served with CARE/MEDICO in Afghanistan where he encountered exotic cutaneous manifestations of small pox, leprosy, tuberculosis and leishmaniasis. He published articles, research papers and book reviews in various medical journals, but was not a prolific author. He regularly attended annual meetings of the Canadian Dermatological Association in cities all across Canada, Mexico City and Dublin. He was a delegate to the International Congresses in London (1952) and Stockholm (1957)

Especially rewarding were his connections with China, which he first visited in 1980 as a member of a small, select group of Canadian dermatologists invited by the government to conduct clinics and present lectures in several hospitals and universities of the Middle Kingdom's six largest cities then open to foreigners. A decade later he served with the Evangelical Medical Aid Society in Wenzhou, Jiangyin, Wuxi, and Nanjing. He returned to China as a tourist on at least three occasions. In the community he was a Rotarian for 30 years, was one of three founders and first president of the Saskatoon Nature Society (formerly Natural History Society) in 1955, and was active in politics as campaigner, treasurer and president of the Saskatchewan Liberal Party. He devoted hours to his interests in genealogy, ornithology, philately and numismatics. He was a voracious reader of newspapers and magazines, and travelled extensively world-wide. Perhaps his deepest involvement was with St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church where he taught Sunday School, served on the Board of Managers and was a member of Session for more than 53 years. For the Presbyterian Church in Canada he was a member of committees and a commissioner to the General Assembly on three occasions, and established the Bremner Memorial Fund in honour of his parents, J. Murray and Catharine Bremner. A Memorial Service will be held on Monday, October 31, at 3 p.m. at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, 436 Spadina Crescent East in Saskatoon, with Rev. Amanda Currie officiating..
