

1. **James Brebner** #5559 b. c 1840 ?, Aberdeen?, ABD, SCT, occupation Shipping Master\*, m. 02 JUN 1865, in Bombay, Bycolla,<sup>1</sup> **Eliza Amelia Bingham** #5560, b. c 1841, London Camberwell, LND, ENG,<sup>2</sup> (daughter of **William Bingham** #43066 and **(unidentified)** #43067) d. 3Q 1897, Lambeth, LND, ENG.<sup>3</sup> listed as "Shipping Master, Bombay" on birth record; 35 Dee Street was place of birth of Bertie 1881 census shows wife at home, "Lieutenant's wife, RN" 1865: Marriage reported in Aberdeen Journal, suggests connections to Aberdeen. \* possibly the son of James BREBNER and Margaret PIRIE ?? \*\* **Eliza**: Lieutenant's Wife, RN 1881

BREBNER (21, b Chichester) and sister-in-law Ada Kathleen HILL (13, b Chichester) also with family.

Seems to have been a Gun Maker at that time.
