"Macleod -- (HNS)-- Funeral services, under the direction of the Calgary branch of the Canadian Legion, for Joseph BREMNER of Macleod, who died Tuesday afternoon in the Col. Belcher hospital, were held at the Leyden Funeral Home, Calgary."

"Cremation followed the committal service."

"Relatives present were his widow, Mr. and Mrs. Jack HUNTLEY, Mr. and Mrs. Wm. BREMNER and Leonard of Macleod; Mrs. James ALLAN and daughter Adrienne of Calgary; Mr. and Mrs. BROOKHART, Edmonton; a sister, Mrs. W.L. SHERA, Creston, B./C., and a nephew, Clarence MCCREA of Cayley."

"BORN IN ONTARIO"

"Born at Manitrick (sic, Manotick) Ontario 78 years ago he came into his youth to the Rathwell district and farmed there. In 1904 he married Miss Mary WOILFE of County Cork, Ireland, who survives. In 1915 he joined the 13th C.M.R.s and went overseas with the Fort Garry Horse. He was invalided from service on the Somme and returned to England in 1917 and in 1918 returned to Canada. He served on the staff of the Hudson's Bay store here until 1922. He led a dance band, the "Gaiety 5" for some time and also had an interest in the Purity Bakery. This was in 1911."

"For several years he acted as caretaker and acting QM until he retired in 1946 and moved, to his farm just east of Macleod. While so serving he resided in the old officer's mess on the barracks square. He had been in poor health for several years, and a patient at the Belcher almost two years."

"Five daughters and four sons and 12 grandchildren beside his widow survive; one brother James of Winnipeg and two sisters, Mrs. W.L. SHERA of Creston. B.C., and Mrs. Tina GOODCHILD of Seattle."

"Melville GOODCHILD, Premedic Student, Succumbs in Seattle Hospital."

"MACLEOD -- Aug. 20 -- Word has just been received in Macleod of the fatal accident in Seattle to a young man who was born in Macleod 20 years ago, his parents being well known residents of Macleod in those days."

"Melville Bremner GOODCHILD was injured on Monday, August 12 when an automobile collided with his motorcycle at 15th street south and Lander street, Seattle, and he died on Thursday in Providence hospital."

"He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. M.D. GOODCHILD, 600 East 45th street, and a pre-medic student at the University of Washington. He belonged to Theta Kappa Theta and De Moloy of the university."

"Rev. Dr. MATTHEWS of First Presbyterian church, Seattle, conducted the funeral services which were held at the Hamilton mortuary, followed by cremation. The fraternity brothers acted as pallbearers."

"The deceased Melville GOODCHILD was the grandson of Mrs. John BREMNER of 20th street, Macleod. His mother was Miss Tina BREMNER before her marriage. She grew up in Macleod, the BREMNER family having been residents in Macleod for many years. The GOODCHILD family moved to Seattle a number of years ago, Mr. GOODCHILD being in business in that city. Much sympathy is being expressed for the family in this sudden bereavement by their old time friends in Macleod."

"Macleod Officer Wins Decoration"

MACLEOD -- Word has recently come to through to Mrs. James ALLAN (nee Alberta BREMNER) of Calgary that her husband, Maj. James Chalmers ALLAN, has been awarded the D.S.O. for distinguished service while serving with the Seaforths of Canada in Italy."

"Major ALLAN is a Macleod boy and formerly employed by Messrs. Plunkett and Savage, and at the time of enlistment, Sept. 9th, 1939, with the Calgary Highlanders, he was manager of that company at Blairmore. Major ALLAN went overseas in November 1940, but was commissioned while acting as platoon S-M at Camp Shilo before he left. In July 1941, he was returned to Canada, and until April 1942, he was instructing in Calgary, where he was again sent overseas and served in North Africa in October 1943."

"HE was severely wounded May 23, 1944, while serving in action in the Liri Valley with the Seaforths of Canada when he was second in command."

"During a severe engagement when our troops had exhausted their ammunition, German tanks riddled them with machine gun fire which caused most of them to take to the ditches where a large number were killed. Major ALLAN, who also took to the ditches feigned death and thus escaped with his life and managed to return to his unit. It is believed it was for his leadership and gallantry during this action that he received his D.S.O. award."

"Major ALLAN, who is the son of Mrs. J. ALLAN and the late Ex-Staff Sergt. John ALLAN of the R.C.M.P. who died suddenly 23 September 1943 in Macleod. He was born in Macleod in December 1914. He was educated in Macleod and Lethbridge schools and later at the Calgary Technical Institute. He is now in a military hospital in England with a bad wound in his thigh received May 23 in Italy. In November, 1939, he married Alberta BREMNER, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph BREMNER of Macleod and they have one daughter Adrienne, now three years old. Major ALLAN has two brothers in the service, John in the navy and George in the army. the latter joining the colors Sept. 11th 1939, going overseas in December of the same year -- the two brothers met several times while serving in Italy. Pte. George ALLAN ins now in Italy but served for some time in North Africa."

"A sister Mrs. H.C. BELL (nee Helen ALLAN), resides in Vancouver and with her husband and three year old son Cameron, is at present visiting her mother, Mr. John ALLAN Sr. at 19th Street, Macleod."
