"Sad Occurrence at Inverness Regatta -- Two Men Drowned."

'A sad case of drowning took place on Saturday night in the Inverness Firth. On that afternoon there was a sailing-boats regatta from Kessock to Munlochy, in which some ten boats took part. Their outward journey was safely effected, and it was on the return that the mishap occurred. One of the boats took the southern shore of the firth, and she was manned by Grigor Mackenzie, sailor; James Paterson, ship carpenter; and John Bremner. When within about two miles of Kessock the boat was struck with a northerly squall, and, the sail being tied, she lurched over at once, and, before the sheet could be slackened, filled with water and sank. Paterson went down with the boat, but Mackenzie and Bremner clung to the oars. One of the other boats proceeded to their assistance, but before they had reached the spot, Bremner, too, had sunk, and Mackenzie was taken on board in a very exhausted state. Neither of the bodies has been recovered. Paterson, whose age was 46, was married, and leaves a widow and family. Bremner was unmarried, and 22 years of age. The unfortunate occurrence will probably put an end to the holding of and annual regatta at Inverness, of which this was to be the inauguration."
