Married 18 FEB 1820 in Aberdeen Old Machar, ABD, SCT,¹ **Janet White** #22418, b. c 1800?.

- i. **(unidentified) Brebner** #22419, b. 03 SEP 1820 in Aberdeen, ABD, SCT,² baptized 11 OCT 1820 in Aberdeen St. Paul's Episcopal, ABD, SCT,² d. 14 OCT 1823 in Aberdeen St. Nicholas, ABD, SCT.³
- ii. **Ann Brebner** #22420, b. 24 JUL 1822 in Aberdeen, ABD, SCT,² baptized 07 AUG 1822 in Aberdeen St. Paul's Episcopal, Aberdeen.²

2. **Robert Brebner** #10695, b. c 1823 in Aberdeen Old Machar, ABD, SCT,⁴ d. 18 MAR 1872 in Old Machar Poorhouse, Aberdeen, ABD,⁵ occupation Combmaker.
 1841: Was Robert living in household of Susan MCPHARLINE on Park Lane, Aberdeen and working as a Seaman?
 1863: Lived 34 Shuttle Lane, Aberdeen at time of marriage. (Illiterate). Note that James BREMNER, b 1840 in Upper Banchory lived at 34 Shuttle Lane in the 1861 census. Are they connected?
 1871: Lived at the Old Machar Poorhouse, St. Machar Place, Aberdeen, ABD.
 1872: Died Old Machar Poor House, note that death certificate states he was unmarried...

Married 30 OCT 1863 in Aberdeen St. Nicholas, ABD, SCT,⁶ **Jane Watson** #10694, b. c 1833 in Glenbervie, KCD, SCT,⁷ (daughter of **Alexander Watson** #10698 and **Isobel Rae** #10699), d. 19 FEB 1869 in Aberdeen Infirmary, ABD, SCT.⁸ **Jane**:
 1841: Lived with family in the Village of Drumlithie, Glenbervie, KCD
 1863: Lived 34 Shuttle Lane at time of marriage.

- i. **Jessie Ann White Brebner** #10696, b. 29 AUG 1865 in Aberdeen St. Nicholas, ABD, SCT,⁹ d. 25 JUN 1868 in 53 East North St., Aberdeen, ABD, SCT.¹⁰
- ii. **William George Brebner** #10697, b. 19 JUL 1867 in Aberdeen St. Nicholas, ABD, SCT,¹¹ d. 03 JUN 1868 in 45 Causewayend, Aberdeen, ABD.¹² age 10 months at death.
